- -Develop future-state user roadmaps.

- -Complete value stream maps to analyze the current state and design a future state for a series of events from internal process to client or customer.
- -Assist teams in implementing targeted measures that are designed to eliminate points of conflict and increase efficiencies
- -Build dashboards using KPIs to bring visibility to newly implemented processes.


